

Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Verona Township Council on March 7, 2019 beginning at 7:30 p.m. in the Municipal Building, 600 Bloomfield Avenue, Verona, New Jersey.

Call to Order:

Municipal Clerk reads notice of Open Public Meetings law.
