A motion was made by Councilman Ryan; seconded by Deputy Mayor Roman that the following resolution be adopted:

**DECLARING AN EMERGENCY FOR PURPOSES AUTHORIZING THE
IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT OF ORDINANCE #2019-26**

WHEREAS, *N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181* permits the waiver of the 20-day estoppel period for the enactment of ordinances upon the adoption of a resolution, by at least two-thirds majority of the Council affirmatively concurring, declaring that an emergency exists necessitating the immediate enactment of the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen affecting the health, safety or welfare of the citizens of the Township of Verona specifically the implementation and enactment of Elmwood Road stop intersections, which failure will affect the safety and welfare of the citizens of the Township; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Township's professionals, it is necessary to immediately remedy the website; and

WHEREAS, immediate enactment of Ordinance #2019-26 is needed as said ordinance will provide traffic calming on Elmwood Road.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Verona, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that an emergency exists as detailed herein for which waiving the 20-day estoppel period for enactment of Ordinance #2019-26 is warranted and justified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Ordinance #2019-26 shall take effect immediately upon final adoption.
