WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the value of the service will exceed \$17,500; and

WHEREAS, the term of this contract is one (1) year and will end on December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available to cover the cost of these services.
