

Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Verona Township Council on Thursday, January 20, 2022, beginning at 7:10 p.m. via Zoom conferencing platform.

Call to Order:

Municipal Clerk reads notice of Open Public Meetings law. The notice requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act have been satisfied with respect to this Special meeting of the Township Council which is being held in the Conference Room in the Community Center located at 880 Bloomfield Avenue, Verona, New Jersey. The agenda and public notice for this meeting was posted in the Municipal Building, and sent the official newspapers of the Township, the Verona-Cedar Grove Times and the Star Ledger, at least 48 hours preceding the start time of this meeting. The purpose of this special meeting is for Council to enter into Executive Session to conduct interviews of candidates for Township Manager.
