What is Cannabis?



- Non-toxic
- Anti-inflammatory
- Neuroprotectant
- Treats chronic pain
- Many active components
- Customizable
- Cannabis has been medicine for millennia; illegal for only a little over 80 years
- Used extensively in the US before prohibition
- With widespread public health education, cannabis will be a cornerstone of healthcare





Is Cannabis Addictive?

- Cannabis is not physically addictive
 - Comparable to coffee
- Patients prefer cannabis
 - Lack of negative side effects, unlike pharmaceuticals
- Cannabis has POSITIVE side effects
 - Better sleep
 - Mood enhancing
 - Stimulates appetite







Has Cannabis Been Researched?



 Some research was conducted in the 40's in the U.S. military, but research picked up considerably in the '6os in Israel.

- US government-owned patent #6630507: Cannabinoids as Antioxidants and Neuroprotectants
- At Pubmed.gov search cannabinoid:
 - 24,000+ studies
- Federal restrictions block traditional side by side blind clinical trials, but they are slowly happening in the US and abroad
 - GW Pharmaceuticals ~ Epidiolex (just approved by the FDA) & Sativex
 - MAPS PTSD Study





New Jersey Medical Marijuana Program





New Jersey Department of Health Medical Marijuana Program

- Maintain a bona fide relationship with a physician who is registered with the program.
- Be a New Jersey resident.
- Be diagnosed with one of the 17 qualifying debilitating medical conditions by a New Jersey health care practitioner registered with the MMP.



Physician Registration: Role of Physicians

- Participation is CRUCIAL to patient access
- Physicians must authorize that patients have one of the 17 approved debilitating medical conditions
- Physician oversight with medical cannabis is needed to avoid, monitor and report adverse events
- Physician monitoring patient success/failures will assist future patients





Patient Registration: Approved Qualifying Conditions

- Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis
- Anxiety
- Cancer
- Chronic Pain
- Dysmenorrhea
- Glaucoma
- Inflammatory bowel disease, including Crohn's disease
- Intractable skeletal spasticity
- Migraine
- Multiple sclerosis
- Muscular dystrophy
- Opioid Use Disorder
- Positive status for HIV and AIDS
- PTSD
- Seizure disorder, including epilepsy
- Terminal illness with prognosis of less than 12 months to live
- Tourette Syndrome





Patient Registration: Online Registration

- Registration is completed online
- <u>https://njmmp.nj.gov/njmmp/jsp/patientRegProcess.jsp</u>
- Patient is to complete all required field on Attending Health Care Practitioner's Statement
- Patient is to complete required patient information
- Patient is to select ATC

*ATC Can be changed online at any time

- Patient is to complete certification
- Patient uploads required documents
- The MMP will review your application and supporting documents. All applications will be responded to via e-mail with further instructions to finalize your application. Approved applicants will be emailed instructions on the MMP epayment process to pay the card fee.





Patient Registration: Required Documents & Fees

Required Documents

- Photograph
- Government Issued photo ID
- Proof of Residency
- Proof of government assistance (if applicable)
- Physician Patient
 Attestation Form

The registration fee for the MMP ID Card is \$200. If a patient qualifies under one of the following categories, they are eligible for a reduced fee of \$20

- Senior Citizens age 65+
- Military Veterans (must submit DD-214 form)
- SSD or SSI
- NJ SNAP
- NJ Medicaid
- NJ Temporary Disability Benefits





Patient Registration: NJMMP Patient ID Card

Once the fee is paid the New Jersey Dept. of Health will issue a Medicinal Marijuana Program ID card.

- Carbon filtration system eliminates odor transfer.
- Stand-alone building
- Absolutely zero on-site consumption
- All employees and registered visitors must be aged 21+





GTI'S GOOD NEIGHBOR PATIENT CODE OF CONDUCT:

To provide a safe environment for ALL patients, staff and neighbors, The following conduct is expected of all persons who enter the dispensary:

For the protection of our customers' privacy and for security reasons, no photography or video recording are permitted in the dispensary.

No food or beverages may be consumed on the sales floor during hours that cannabis (marijuana) is being dispensed, unless necessary for medical reasons.

No loitering outside of the dispensary before or after completing a transaction.

No consumption or vaporization of cannabis (marijuana) in the dispensary, the parking lot, or the surrounding area.

Wait until reaching a private residence/property before opening any cannabis (marijuana) product. Open products in the vehicle or in public may violate local and state laws.

Do not distribute, sell, or share your cannabis (marijuana) products. Doing so violates local and state laws.

Any inappropriate action or language is cause for being asked to leave the dispensary. Repeated offenses will result in permanent refusal of service.
