RESOLUTION No. 2020-195

A motion was made by Councilwoman McGrath; seconded by Councilman Ryan that the following resolution be adopted:

AUTHORIZING TAX SALE WITHOUT DELINQUENT SEWER CHARGES

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2020, Governor Murphy issued Executive Order 190 which, among other things, requires that *“No gas or electric public or municipal utility or privately or publicly owned water system shall collect any fee or charge imposed for late or otherwise untimely payments or service reconnections that have accrued, and will continue to accrue, during the Public Health Emergency”*; and

WHEREAS, the Township shall conduct an upcoming tax sale on December 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector has determined that in order to fully comply with the requirements of Executive Order 190, the Township should not sell any sewer delinquencies at the December 3, 2020 tax sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Verona, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey that the Tax Collector shall proceed with the December 3, 2020 tax sale but shall not sell any sewer delinquencies at said tax sale in order to fully comply with Executive Order 190.
