

## **Domestic Violence**

Temporary Restraining Orders

## If this is an emergency or you are in imminent danger, call 9-1-1 immediately.

If you want to apply for a temporary restraining order due to domestic violence:

- You can apply for a restraining order at the courthouse in person, Monday through Friday, during business hours. We are open and available to help you.
- You can also apply for a temporary restraining order by calling the courthouse at \_\_\_\_\_\_ during business hours.
  If you call after 4 p.m., you can leave a message and court staff will return your call the next business day. If this is an emergency or you are in imminent danger, call 9-1-1 immediately.
- If you leave a message, give your name, phone number, and a safe time for court staff to return your call.
- After business hours and on weekends and holidays, you can apply for a temporary restraining order by contacting your local police department.
