Farm Camp supports youth development by promoting a positive interest in nature, historical living, and agriculture. Our mission is to provide the best camp experience for youth, while also providing a beneficial learning experience about food, animals, our earth, and its agricultural past. Our campers have the chance to be in the garden each day and participate in activities related to each age level's theme.

- **All camp fees are nonrefundable. When registering online, there will be a \$5 tee-shirt and water bottle fee and a processing fee based on total costs.**
- Camp discounts available:
 - Early bird registration before March 1: \$25 per registration
 - Contact our staff about payment assistance scholarships for camp.
- 8:30 am drop off available for all weeks at a \$25/child fee.
- Please note there are late pick-ups on Fridays each week as we will be offsite on field trips.
- Counselor in Training (CIT) opportunities are available for ages 12-16 for select camp weeks. Youth willing to serve as peer mentors while participating in camp activities are welcome to register at \$100/camp week. Online registration is still required for CITs and a mandatory orientation day in June.
- Campers must be the required age of the camp week registered by June 1st.
- Camp will be held rain or shine and we will do our best to keep the camp outdoors. In cases of light showers, youth will continue outside. In cases of storms, youth will be inside. Wear clothes that can get dirty and wet.
- Snacks will be provided and various foods from the garden will be offered for taste tests. **Please**
