BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENT AND SUMMARY

Ordinance No. 2021-13

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township of Verona, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey on May 3, 2021 and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such bond ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADA IMPROVEMENTS AT TOWN HALL AND ADA IMPROVEMENTS NEEDED TO FACILITATE VOTING AT FN BROWN SCHOOL IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF VERONA, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$195,000 THEREFOR, INCLUDING \$99,840 EXPECTED TO BE RECEIVED AS A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$195,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE THE COST THEREOF

Purpose(s): ADA improvements at Town Hall and ADA improvements needed to facilitate voting at FN Brown School, including site work, work, materials and equipment necessary or related thereto and incidental costs

Appropriation: \$195,000

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$195,000

Grants (if any) Appropriated: \$99,840 Community Development Block Grant

Section 20 Costs: \$39,000

Useful Life: 15 years
