NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

Ordinance No. 2021-19

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Verona, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey, on June 7, 2021. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held both in person in the Municipal Building, 600 Bloomfield Avenue and via a Zoom video conference. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR UPGRADES TO THE 911 SYSTEM IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF VERONA, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$245,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$233,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE THE COST THEREOF

Purpose(s): upgrades to the 911 system, including all costs necessary therefor or incidental thereto

Appropriation: \$245,000

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$233,000

Grants (if any) Appropriated: \$0

Section 20 Costs: \$49,000

Useful Life: 10 years
