Arbor Day Foundation Names Verona Township “A Tree City USA”

Verona Township was named a Tree City USA by the Arbor Day Foundation in honor of its commitment to effective urban forest management.

The Tree City USA program is sponsored by the Arbor Day Foundation in partnership with the U.S. Forest Service and the National Association of State Foresters.

Verona achieved Tree City USA recognition by meeting the program’s requirements: 1.) a tree board or department, 2.) a tree-care ordinance, 3.) an annual community forestry budget of at least \$2 per capita and 4.) an Arbor Day observance and proclamation.
