NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

ORDINANCE 2026-26

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Verona, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey, on June 8, 2026. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building, in the Township on June 22, 2026 at 7 o'clock p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of the full bond ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ACQUISITION OF RESCUE SQUAD AMBULANCE AND EQUIPMENT IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF VERONA, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$390,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$371,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF

Purpose(s): Acquisition of Rescue squad ambulance, including related costs and expenditures necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

Appropriation: \$390,000

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$371,000

Grants (if any) Appropriated: N/A

Section 20 Costs: \$78,000

Useful Life: 15 years
