I have reviewed the submitted site plans to remove seven existing tennis courts and practice area to construct six new tennis courts. The upper portion of the existing golf practice range will be regraded. In addition, underground drainage and re-sodding in the lower portion of the golf practice range will be installed. I offer the following comments for the Planning Board's consideration:

- 1. The applicant shall provide testimony as to where the existing shed on drawing #LA-100 is being relocated.
- 2. The applicant shall secure all Essex County approvals and permits for the construction work along Mount Prospect Avenue.
- 3. Applicant shall provide testimony on proposed landscaping, fencing, etc. to minimize nuisance characteristics and for aesthetic concerns to adjacent properties.
- 4. All overhead lighting design must be approved by the Township of Verona Engineer and shall be designed and operated so as not to reflect or shine on adjacent properties. Parking spaces and ways shall be clearly marked.
- 5. HEP Soil Conservation District approval must be obtained and soil conservation measures put in place prior to any disturbance of site.

- 6. All storm water management must be approved by the Township of Verona Engineer.
- 7. All construction permits must be applied for and approved by the Verona Building Department with two signed and sealed drawings from a licensed architect in the State of New Jersey.
