

VERONA COMMUNITY POOL 2019 RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Members and guests must comply with the rules. Members are responsible for their guests.
- 2. Following items are strictly enforced in the pool perimeter;
 - a. Walking of bicycles within the pool gates.
 - b. Skate Boards will be turned into the office.
 - c. Water pistols of any kind are prohibited.
 - d. No bouncing of balls on the pool deck.
- 3. Only children up to the age of 6 will be permitted in the baby pool.
- 4. All children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult (18 years of age or over) to be admitted to the pool complex.
- 5. No smoking on pool premises.
- 6. Playground equipment to be used by children up to the age of 6. Foot wear is required while in the playground area.
- 7. It is required that patrons shower upon leaving the volleyball court, prior to entering the pool.
- 8. Only adult memberships can purchase a guest pass.
- 9. During weekend adult swims, only 1 child, 5 years old or younger may accompany one adult.
- 10. No diving into the pool except from the diving boards. Jump feet first only off the 5 ft. wall.
- 11. Proper pool membership badges must be processed to enter the pool.
- 12. Lost membership badges must be reported to the Front Office or Office of Community Services immediately.
- 13. No flotation devices are permitted in the main pool.
- 14. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited on pool property.
- 15. Management may close the pool whenever the safety or health of the membership is endangered and may prohibit any action or conduct which is dangerous, improper, illicit or immoral.
- 16. There shall be no animals, littering, glass or breakable containers allowed.

- 17. Food and drink are restricted to the refreshment area, picnic area and picnic tables. Please use trash containers when cleaning up your area.
- 18. Swimmers are required to clear the water 20 minutes prior to closing.
- 19. Parents are responsible for their children. An adult must accompany children 5 and under at all times.
- 20. Diapers must be changed in the rest room area and disposed of in the container provided. Absolutely no changing of diapers on picnic tables.
- 21. According to N.J.A.C. 8:26-5.4, All children in diapers must wear plastic pants with snug fitting elastic waist and leg bands when entering pool.
- 22. Membership in the Verona Community Pool is limited to Verona residents only. Members are allowed in the pool facility only during regular operating hours.
- 23. Any person having a communicable disease, open blisters, cuts, sore or inflamed eyes, ears, nose or mouth infections, excessive sunburn or any type of skin disease will be excluded from the pool area.
- 24. There shall be no running or throwing of objects.
- 25. Unnecessary spouting of water, snapping of towels, roughness, or other conduct affecting the safety and comfort of others, shall not be permitted.
- 26. No loitering in the vicinity of Lifeguard stands, entrance ladders, stairs or ramp.
- 27. Non-members attending special parties are required to pay the guest fees and wear Guest wristbands.
- 28. Pool patrons are not permitted to put up personal tents or umbrellas on pool property.
- 29. The babysitter badge, can only be used when the babysitter is with the children listed on the same membership.
- 30. Patrons who occupy tables must be present on the pool premises. Members are encouraged to share tables.
