Verona Community Pool Complex Private Party Rental

The Verona Community Pool Complex is available for private organizations to rent. The entirety of the pool grounds are available to rent during non-operating hours between Memorial Day weekend and the first day of full-time operation, June 20th 2025. This includes all weekdays (except Memorial Day) from 8am - 8pm. Rentals are at the discretion of the Verona Recreation Department.

Pool complex grounds include Olympic size pool and dive tank with two diving boards, two water slides, baby pool, interactive splash pad, picnic tables and chairs. Access to recreation includes basketball and volley ball courts as well as shuffle board, corn hole and ping pong. DJ and/or other forms of musical entertainment are allowed. Recreational Department will confirm 3rd party insurance rider needs upon booking.

Pricing: \$3,225/ per hour (2 hour minimum/\$6,450)

Includes the following staff for up to 250 people*

- 16 Lifeguards
- 4 front office employees
- 3 maintenance staff
- 2 managers

*A guest list with all attendees (adults, children and guardians) must be provided to Verona Township. Any attendants of the party that are not on the list provided will incur an additional \$25 per guest fee. If the guest list is over 250 the township must be notified at least two weeks in advance in order to ensure the pool complex is properly staffed. Maximum pool capacity is 1,000.

In the event of an emergency, such as lightning, there must be either (1) enough adults to take all children off pool grounds and to safety immediately, with cars assigned before the party, or (2) all parents must confirm that they or someone else (who they must sign off on) can pick their child up at a moment's notice. In the event of an emergency where these conditions are not met, the organization will not be permitted to rent the facilities the following year.
