 - 1) Merlot Redbud
 - 2) Japanese Tree Lilac (backup choice)
 - <u>Medium Trees</u> that SHOULD NOT be planted anywhere we have overhead power lines or interferences (20'- 30' tall max):
 - 1) Maackia
 - 2) Yellowwood (backup choice)
